# USER MANUAL

#### **FEATURES**

- · Time: 12/24H format
- Calendar: 2000/1/1 ~ 2099/12/31
- · Weekday display
- · Alarm and snooze: 5 minutes snooze time
- Indoor temperature range: 0°C~ 50°C (32°F ~ 122°F)
- · Indoor humidity range: 20% ~ 95%
- · Comfort level indicator
- · White backlight turns on for 10 seconds when in use
- Hole for hanging
- · Foldable stand
- Power consumption: 2 x AAA batteries (not included)

#### OPERATION

- 1) To enter time mode; press MODE key until "TIME" is displayed on the upper left corner
- 2) Under time mode, press MODE key once to view calendar
- 3) Under time mode, press MODE key twice to view alarm time
- 4) Under time mode, press or hold the UP key to switch time format to 12/24H
- 5) Under time mode, press or hold the DOWN key to switch temperature display to °C or °F

#### TIME SETTING

- Under time mode, hold the MODE key for 3 seconds to enter time setting mode
  - The setting sequence is Hour -> Minute -> Exit. To move from one to the next, press MODE
- Press the UP key once to adjust the time forward press the DOWN key once to adjust the time back. Hold the UP or DOWN key for 2 seconds to adjust faster
  - The setting will be confirmed and exited without any actions after 30 seconds

# 12/24H HOUR FORMAT

Under time mode, press or hold UP key to switch the time display between 12H and 24H format



# CALENDAR SETTING

after 30 seconds

- Under time mode, press the MODE key once to view the calendar Hold the MODE key for 3 seconds to enter the calendar setting The setting sequence is Year -> Month -> Date -> Exit To move from one to the next, press MODE
- 2) Press the UP key once to adjust the date forward press the DOWN key once to adjust the date back. Hold the UP or DOWN key for 2 seconds to adjust faster The setting will be confirmed and exited without any actions

#### ALARM AND SNOOZE SETTING

 Under time mode, press the MODE key twice to view alarm time, then hold the MODE key for 3 seconds to enter alarm setting mode.

The setting sequence is Alarm hour -> Alarm minute -> Exit To move from one to the next, press MODE

 Press the UP key once to adjust the time forward – press the DOWN key once to adjust the time back. Hold the UP or DOWN key for 2 seconds to adjust faster

The setting will be confirmed and exited without any actions after 30 seconds

When the alarm goes off, the alarm icon  $\spadesuit$  will flash. The alarm sound will change as below:

- · 0-10 seconds: 1 BI sound/sec
- · 11-20 seconds: 2 BI sound/sec
- · 21-30 seconds: 4 BI sound/sec
- · After 30 seconds: continue BI sound

The sound will automatically stop after 1 minute. The alarm will repeat at the set time each day, unless turned off or reset

When the alarm is on, press the MODE key to activate the snooze function for 5 minutes. The snooze icon **zz** will flash Press any key to stop the snooze function

# ALARM ON/OFF

Under alarm time mode, press or hold the UP or DOWN key to turn on/off alarm function

# TEMPERATURE DISPLAY FORMAT

Under time mode, press or hold DOWN key to switch temperature display in °C or °F
